

ANNUAL AHERA NOTIFICATION

South Ripley Community School Corporation

School Year 2015-2016

Under the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986, South Ripley Community School Corporation is required to annually notify all school building employees, building occupants or their legal guardians, of the availability and location of the Asbestos Management Plans and of any post-response action activities, including periodic reinspections and surveillance activities that are planned or in progress.

We are happy to report that all South Ripley Community School Corporation School Buildings have been thoroughly inspected and that there are no asbestos-containing building materials in any part.

However, state and federal law requires that we notify you annually that we maintain an asbestos management plan for each building. The AHERA Management Plan(s) is/are available for public review in the Superintendent's office, during normal working hours, and within five days of request at individual school buildings. A reasonable charge will be made for the requested copies of the Management Plan(s).
